How to Hide File Formats in the Printing Preferences

The file format dropdown list contains several file formats on the File Format tab in the Printing Preferences. You can specify which file formats are in the dropdown list, so you can determine what file formats can be used. For example, if you want to hide the JPEG format you should add the following to the printer driver INI file:

```
[UI FileFormats]
JPEG File=0
```

The keyname in the INI file has to be equal to the name of the file format in the dropdown list. In this case the keyname is "JPEG File". NOTE: You have to leave at least one file format that supports monochrome color depth, one file format that

supports 8 bit color depth and one file format that supports 24 bit color depth in the dropdown list. For example if you hide all file formats except Microsoft DIB format, this is fine, because the Microsoft DIB format supports monochrome, 8 bit and 24 bit images.

New Digitally Signed Printer Driver Files

The printer driver files (version 10.06) are all digitally signed. You can check the information of the digital signature when you open the properties dialog of the driver file. The timestamp information is saved in the digital signature.
